### **Family Law Email List Use Policy**

#### **PURPOSE**

To facilitate and encourage the free flow of information necessary to maintain an informed and engaged Oregon State Bar Family Law Section community, the Family Law Section an email distribution list of its members to which it can disseminate information. The primary goal of this resource is for the transmission of timely and officially sanctioned information of general interest to all members of the family law community.

Access to the email distribution list is governed by the policies listed below:

#### **POLICY**

The following conditions set forth the manner in which parties are authorized to access and use the Family Law Section email distribution list.

#### **Terms of Use:**

Access to the Family Law Section's email distribution list must be pre-approved by a sitting member of the Family Law Section Executive Committee.

Using the email distribution list for commercial purposes or personal business (e.g., buying, selling items, advertising for profit endeavors) or private gain is discouraged and may not be approved/authorized.

The use of the resource in connection with contests, chain letters, junk e-mail or "spam" is prohibited.

The use of the resource to falsely impersonate an individual, group, organization or entity is prohibited.

The Family Law Section Executive Committee shall at all times be authorized to use its discretion in determining whether a proposed distribution shall be allowed.

**Modification of Terms:** The policies discussed herein may be modified without notice when it is deemed reasonable and necessary.

**Exclusion From Use:** The use of the Family Law Section's email distribution list is a privilege, not a right. The Family Law Section Executive Committee may restrict, remove or limit a party's right to access this resource with or without notice.
